





## Import submissions

No changes required to document content or hyperlinks



### View source document from docbase

File-system path hyperlinks are automatically converted to Documentum URLs to the target document in Documentum



#### Click on the link

The hyperlink correctly opens the target document for viewing from Documentum



## **Export submissions**

No changes required to document content or hyperlinks, MD5 checksum is therefore unaffected



# Inter-document hyperlinks – the problem

Submission documents can contain hyperlinks (cross-references) to other documents. The targets of these hyperlinks are determined according to a folder path on a file system, relative to the location of the source document, and have to be this way for submission to regulatory authorities. Many companies store their submissions in Documentum, and for these hyperlinks to be "clickable" when viewing from Documentum requires converting them from file system links (e.g.
